Visiting Nursing Association – Bremer County Public Health will offer a H1N1 shot clinic on Thursday December 3rd from 4:00 – 7:00 pm at Redeemer Lutheran Church 2001 W. Bremer Avenue in Waverly **by appointment only**.

This clinic is only for the following priority groups:

- pregnant women
- parents, siblings, or care providers for infants under 6 months of age
- health care and emergency medical services personnel
- children aged 6 months – 24 years and
- adults aged 25 -64 years with chronic medical conditions. Chronic medical conditions may include lung disease (asthma, COPD, emphysema), heart disease (except hypertension), kidney or liver disease, diabetes, neurologic or blood or immune illness.
